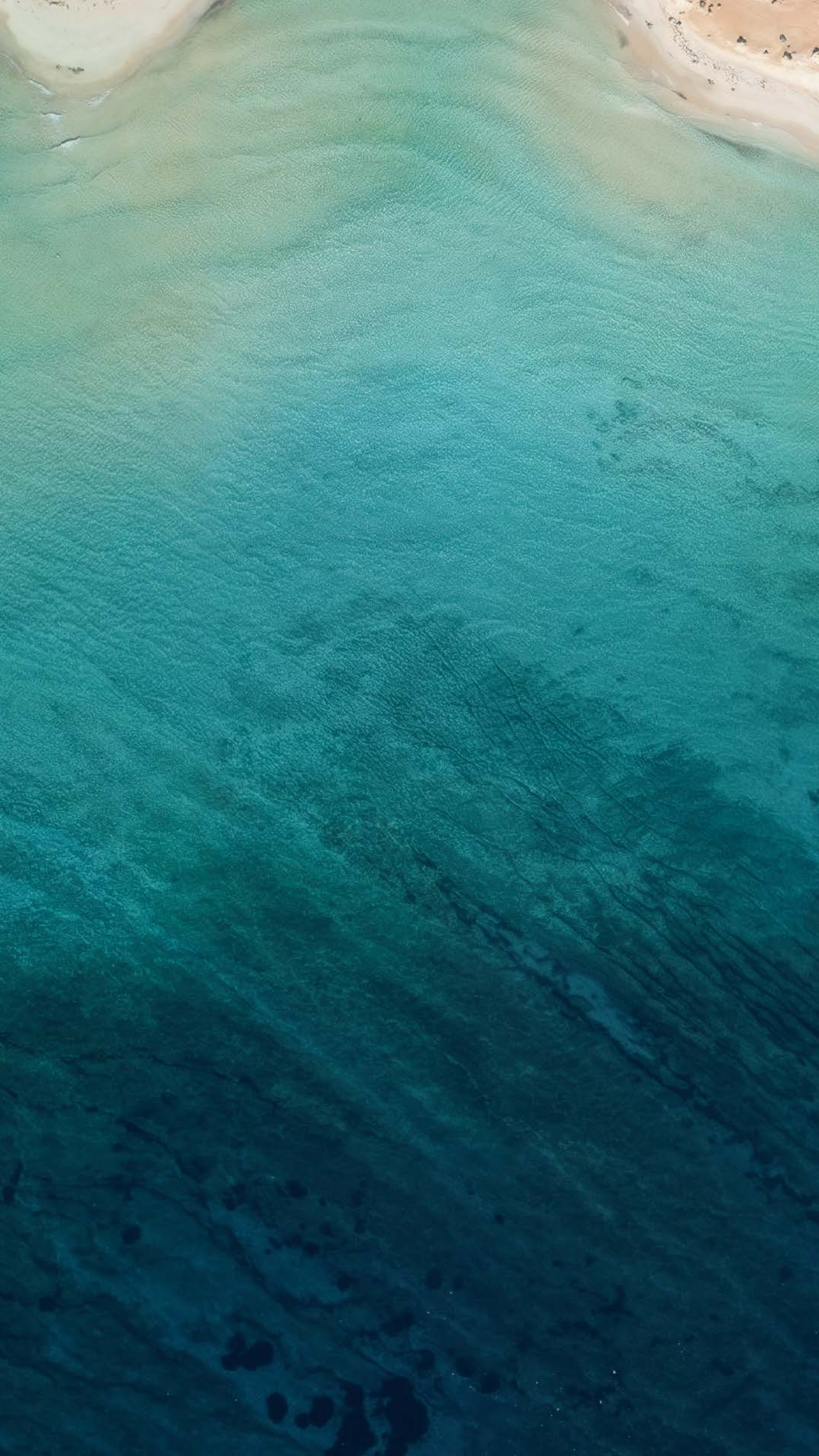

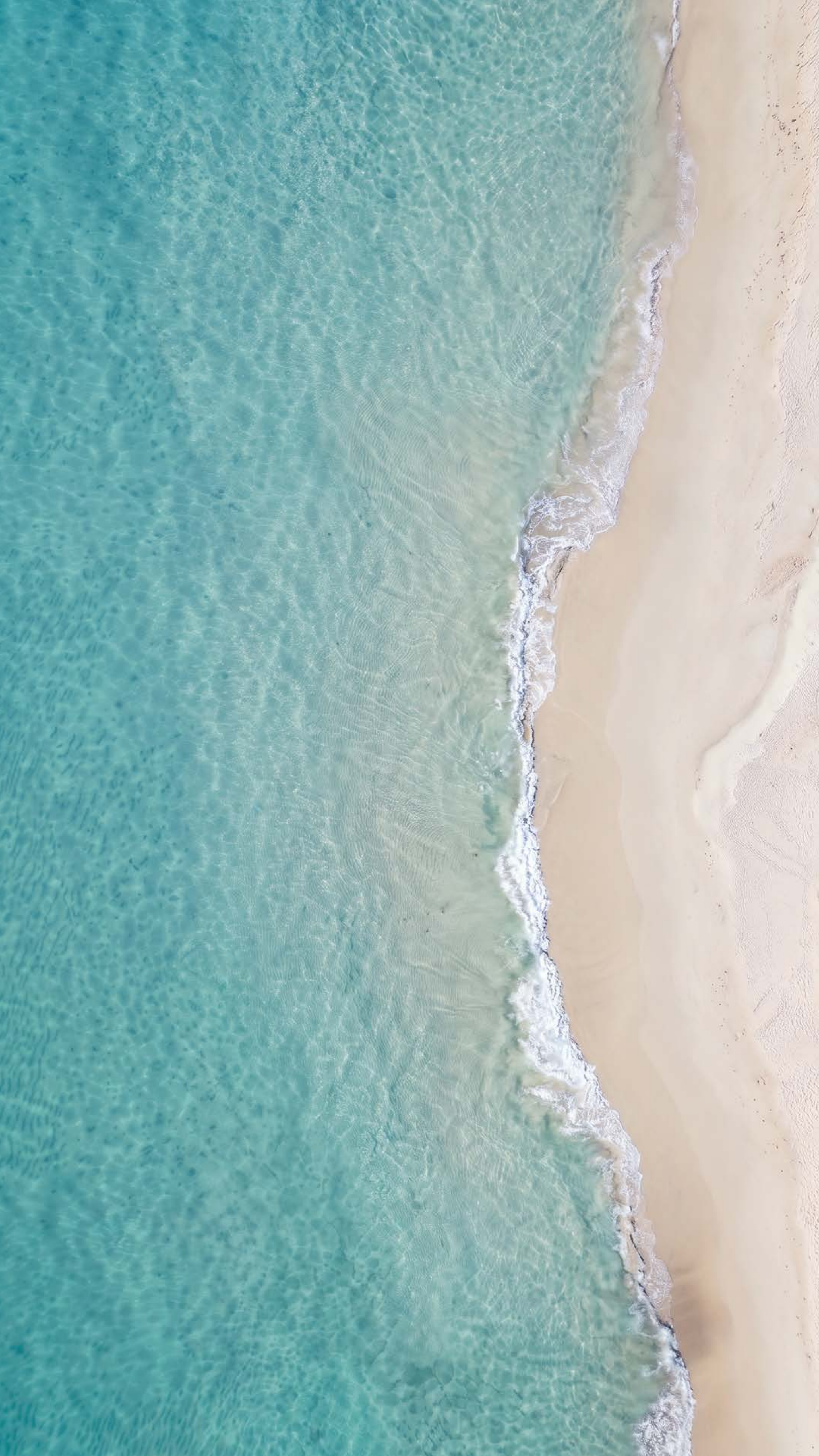
A NATIONAL COMMITMENT

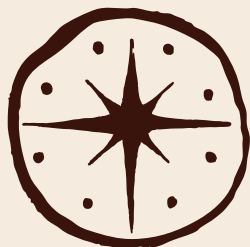

The Story of Alam Al Roum

Sailors crossing the open Mediterranean watched for it. When it rose from the water, they knew they were near harbour, near shelter, near home. The Romans named it a landmark.

They called it *Alam Al Roum*.



Then, for a long time, the coast forgot. It became a line, a westward drift of seasons, each shore opened and abandoned for the next, a journey that erased its own footsteps and never arrived anywhere worth staying.

But the light that guided those ancient ships never left. The shape of the bay did not change. The calm of the sheltered water held. The coast was always waiting to be remembered.

Now, it is.

Alam Al Roum is the return of this coast to its meaning, restored in full, in all its scale, all its grandeur, all its light.

The oldest landmark on the Egyptian Mediterranean is also its newest beginning.

Overview & Vision

Egypt’s Mediterranean, restored.

Along 7.2 kilometres of Mediterranean shoreline, fifteen minutes from Marsa Matrouh International Airport, a 4,902-feddan coastal city is taking shape. Within a short flight of Europe and the Gulf, it introduces a new standard for coastal living.

Masterplanned by Skidmore, Owings & Merrill (SOM), the city is designed as one connected destination. A grand boulevard links the shoreline to the heart of the city, while twenty-eight kilometres of swimmable lagoons bring the water into every neighbourhood. Distinct districts are connected by a continuous landscape spine, creating a walkable city with a strong sense of place.

Designed for year-round living and generations to come, it is a destination of lasting permanence, built at the scale its history deserves.



Where the world meets the Mediterranean.

At the heart of the Mediterranean Sea, where the African continent meets the open sea, lies a place of rare geographic advantage. This is the North Coast of Egypt, the western gateway of the Mediterranean, where the world meets the Mediterranean.

Alam Al Roum sits at a point of rare geographic advantage, on Egypt's North Coast, at the western gateway of the Mediterranean, where the African continent meets the open sea.

05 Strategic Location

Locally

The site commands the finest stretch of Egypt's North Coast: 7.2 kilometres of naturally sheltered shoreline on the bay of Alam Al Roum, fifteen minutes from Marsa Matrouh International Airport, and connected by the Alexandria–Matrouh coastal road.

Regionally

Alam Al Roum sits within a short flight of Cairo, the Gulf capitals, and the major cities of Europe, making it as accessible to international visitors as it is to Egypt's own residents.

Globally

A City Built Around the Sea

Alam Al Roum carries the civic substance of a true city: a vibrant coastal lifestyle, dynamic waterfront destinations, town centres that trade through every season, a thriving freezone economy, a longevity and medical quarter, and educational institutions. Sport, culture and gathering grounds are woven through each district.

Its neighbourhoods are shaped by a strong sense of place: walkable, climate-responsive streets, homes oriented towards water and light, and intimate communities within a city of lasting significance. A continuous mobility loop links every district, designed for people before vehicles.

07 Lighthouse Boulevard & Gateway

Every enduring destination is announced before it is entered. At Alam Al Roum, arrival begins at the Gateway, an architectural threshold marking the transition from coast road to coastal City.

From here, the boulevard unfolds as a grand avenue leading the eye toward the water. Framed by landscape and animated by light, its central axis aligns with the summer solstice sunrise, a deliberate celebration of new horizons.

At its end stands the Lighthouse, the beacon of Alam Al Roum. Rising above the marina and Cultural Pier, it anchors the city's horizon. By day it is a landmark. By evening it becomes a flame on the Mediterranean. At the summer solstice, it serves as the focal point for the city's international festivals. It is the first thing the sea sees of Alam Al Roum and the last thing held in memory.

08 Water Experiences

Water is the first language of Alam Al Roum: 7.2 kilometres of Mediterranean beachfront, twenty-eight of lagoon frontage, and canals that carry the sea into the city's heart.

The Beachfront

Alam Al Roum's shoreline is among the most generous on Egypt's North Coast, with 7.2 kilometres of soft sand along a naturally sheltered bay where calm waters invite bathing throughout the season. Each stretch of beach has its own character, from lively promenades to quiet coves that meet the tideline. A continuous promenade traces the full length of the shore.

The Lagoons

Inland, twenty-two kilometres of crystalline swimmable lagoons bring the waterfront deep into the city. Homes open directly onto the water, with gardens giving way to landscaped edges where a generation of children learns to swim close to home. The lagoons form the city's second coastline and the heart of family life.

The Canals

Through the city's centre, a signature canal walk animates daily life. Lined with cafés, retail and waterfront dining, it carries water taxis and quiet currents alike, connecting the boulevard to the marina in one continuous, walkable thread.

09 Landscape Experience

*Nature, woven

The landscape of Alam Al Roum, shaped by SWA, is the green structure that binds the city's districts into one. At its core runs the Spine: a continuous corridor of gardens, shaded walks and trails linking every neighbourhood from the Gateway to the sea – more than thirty kilometres of paths, and the route along which daily life moves on foot.

From it, each neighbourhood draws a distinct landscape character, expressed through its own planting palette, rhythm and mood. Together, they create a landscape of remarkable depth, where every district feels unique and every walk reveals something new. The planting itself is rooted in the place. Native and climate-adapted species are preserved and propagated, sustaining biodiversity and easing the city's thirst.

Throughout, the lagoon and canal network performs a quiet and essential task: a natural water system that manages stormwater, sustains the wetlands, and keeps the waters clear. Here, beauty does the work of engineering.

10 Hospitality Experience

Alam Al Roum hosts a calibre of hospitality the Mediterranean reserves for its most celebrated coasts. Ultra-luxury resorts carry the signatures of the world's most distinguished houses, spoken in the same breath as the Riviera; between them, intimate boutique hotels offer a quieter register.

Inland, wellness retreats and a longevity quarter extend hospitality into the science of living well. Across every tier, the intent holds: arrival should feel like an occasion, and every return like coming home.

11 Marina & Boating Experiences

Alam Al Roun returns Egypt's North Coast to the Mediterranean's great circuit of harbours, offering three distinct ways to meet the water.

The International Marina

At the heart of the city, an international standard marina, designed and operated by Marina Projects, one of the world's leading marina specialists, is built to receive vessels of significant scale. Its waterfront promenade of dining and retail draws residents and visitors from dawn into the night. It is the social centre of Alam Al Roun and its window to the wider sea.

12 Town Centres & Retail

The town centres are the social and cultural anchors of Alam Al Roum: walkable, mixed-use quarters where commerce, creativity and community meet. Ground-floor retail and waterfront dining sit alongside galleries, café terraces and open-air programming, looking out across the lagoons and trading year-round.

From the morning espresso to the late dinner, this is where the city keeps its rhythm.

13 Golf Experience

At the northern reach of Alam Al Roum, an eighteen-hole championship course is set into the natural contours of the land, its front nine threading the edges of a natural lagoon, its back nine running along the open Mediterranean.

Three signature holes are drawn directly above the sea, where play pauses for the view. A clubhouse and golf academy anchor the course, and the residences that line its fairways enjoy one of the most coveted outlooks in the city: green to one side, blue to the other.

Homes of Alam Al Roum

A collection of homes shaped by light, water and time.

The homes of Alam Al Roum span the full register of coastal living, from lagoon-front apartments to standalone villas, from townhouses with sun decks on the water to the signature estates of the Royal Quarter.
